> Transportation from the airport is on your own. The hotel is next to the Whittlesford Parkway Train Station and one stop away from Cambridge. If you fly into Heathrow or Gatwick, you can take the tube and trains to the hotel. The cost would be around £80 from Gatwick round trip and £60 from Heathrow. (Estimated costs at the time of writing this article!) The trip would involve changing a couple of times and going into London to the Liverpool Street Station. You will need to make your reservation with the hotel direct. Nine rooms have been held for this event under the guest name "Bomb Group" checking in Friday, May 27th, checking out on Tuesday, May 31st. The hotel phone number is 441223497070.

The only additional and unknown cost at this time is the transportation during the reunion. A bus will be hired, but until we know how many people are attending, we will not know the costs. We will do our best to keep these costs as low as possible. It is advisable to check the current currency conversion rates before traveling.
