- E/A attacks on this group Nil. Four Me-262's were sighted in target area about 1400. The fighters were not attacking this Group but one came through from behind out of contrails and one crew claims 1 destroyed.

 - d. 1416 5040-1210 16,000 Large convoy of trucks between two small towns.
 - e. 1505 5042-0915 12,000 Large explosion with dense white smoke rising to sky. Ship off Ostend still burning from yesterday.
