The museum is located adjacent to the airfield at the rear of The Woodman Inn in Nuthampstead, England. The original trustees, Andrew Grisbrooke, Geoff Rice, Russell Abbey, Marilyn Gibb-Rice and Christine Barry started working diligently in 2010 to make this dream come true.

Fundraising began in June 2010 and received a huge boost once plans were announced at the 398<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group Memorial Association annual reunion held in Denver that year. The fundraising effort continues with “Founding Memberships” to the museum. These memberships are limited to 131 US and 131 UK members. Each member will receive a plaque and a certificate. Efforts have been used to help defray the construction costs of all three buildings and the Memorial Garden.
